Objectives:

The Objectives are for Power Electrics Ltd to operate as an environmentally aware and caring company. This is to be demonstrated through compliance with best practice guidelines and all relevant legislation.

- 1.0 Implement and maintain effective management systems which will comply fully with existing and future legislation.
- 1.1 Increase training to promote the environmental awareness and understanding of staff, both emergency and environmental.
- 1.2 Utilise products that have excellent environmental characteristics and which meet the highest demands of efficiency, throughout their life cycle.
- 1.3 Communicate with suppliers and customers to facilitate the best possible environmental practices.
- 1.4 Reduce the volume of waste produced and operate where possible a recycling programme.
- 1.5 Improve the visual appearance of our operational sites.

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Targets:

Our main targets are to achieve standards in excess of the current and planned environmental legislation, to implement ISO 14001:1996 management system into our methods of working.

2.0 Promote the understanding and support of staff with appropriate environmental awareness sessions. Environmental awareness is to be included in the induction training for all new staff.

2.1 Implement and maintain effective environmental management systems and implement internal audit.

2.2 Comply fully with both the spirit and the letter of current and future environmental legislation and best industry practices, investing ahead, where appropriate, of legislative requirements.

2.3 Minimise adverse environmental effects by utilizing and marketing products that have excellent environmental characteristics and which meet the highest demands of efficiency.

2.4 Communicate with suppliers to facilitate the best possible environmental practices. Review on an on-going basis the selection and purchasing of materials to ensure the minimum of adverse environmental impact.

2.5 Support energy conservation by promoting energy efficiency and "switch off" campaigns which make better use of resources and improve environmental standards.

2.6 Reduce through various procedures the volume of waste produced, utilising recyclable materials where possible.

2.7 Minimise the level of harmful emissions. Exhaust emissions to be minimized by regular routine preventative maintenance procedures of both plant and vehicle fleets. All significant effects to water to be monitored and minimized to comply with legislation.

2.8 All delivery and maintenance vehicles to be equipped with and staff trained in the use of fuel oil spillage control equipment.

2.9 Every year assess the progress of the Environmental Policy and adjust as necessary to keep abreast of changes. Policy to be reviewed annually as a minimum.

3.0 Implement a system of continual improvement of environmental performance through regularly auditing performance.
